The Ramapo Romp

(Written in honor of my son Gregory's graduation from Ramapo College in May 2002) Circle Mixer, Begin in a big circle of partners

- A1 (8) All into the center and back
 - (8) Women into the center, turn around and come back, facing partner
- A2 (8) Woman takes two hands with partner and pulls him into the center; Then pushes him out (or he pulls her out)
 - (8) Partner Dosado (with counterclockwise individual twirls)
- B1 (8) All turn 1/4 to own right and go single file, women clockwise in center ring, men counterclockwise in outer ring
 - (8) Turn around and come back, pass partner
- B2 (16) with the next one (new partner) Balance and Swing.

Prompting Version of The Ramapo Romp:

- ----, -- Wheelbarrow pull and push
- ----, -- Dosado with Twirls

Extend Application Ideas for Wheel Around from Ted Lizotte, Extended Application Session, CALLERLAB, April 2011

1) Heads Square Thru 2, Swing Thru, Boys Run, Bend the Line, Pass Thru, Wheel and Deal, Centers Wheel Around ("keep turning to face the ones behind you"), Allemande Left

2) Heads Lead Right, Veer Left, Ladies Chain Down the Line, Dixie Style to a Wave, Boys Trade, Left Swing Thru, Girls Run, "Everyone Wheel Around, Girls will connect – Girls Trade" Ferris Wheel, Centers Pass Thru, Square Thru 3, Allemande Left

3) Heads Lead Right, Circle to a Line (Zero Line), Right and Left Thru, Dixie Style to a Wave, Boys Trade, Left Swing Thru, Girls Run, Wheel Around, Ladies Chain Down the Line, (Zero Line)

4) Heads Star Thru and Pass Thru, Slide Thru, Right and Left Thru, Dixie Style to a Wave, Boys Trade, Left Swing Thru, Girls Run, Ferris Wheel, Centers Wheel Around, Allemande Left

Texas Star Original and Variations as suggested by Betsy Gotta Beginner Dance Party Leader's Seminar, Callerlab, April 2011 in Las Vegas

Texas Star as listed in "Square and Folk Dancing by Hank Greene 1984

- 1. Ladies Center and Back to the Bar
- 2. Gents to the center and form a star, it's right hand round and there you are
- 3. Back with your left, don't go too far, just meet your partner, pass her by, hook the next gal on the fly
- 4. The gents swing out, the ladies swing in, (can turn 1 1/2) form that Texas Star again.
- 5. Break the star, the new girl swing
- 6. Now Promenade around the ring

Modern Variation for Men in the center:

Everybody go forward and back Men make a right hand star Men turn around and make a left hand star Pick up your partner, Star Promenade Inside out, outside in (men back out, ladies walk forward to make a star) (Depending on the crowd, you can have the couples turn 1 1/2 instead of 1/2 to change places) Centers back out, Swing your Partner, Promenade home

Modern Variation for Ladies in the center:

Everybody go forward and back Ladies make a right hand star Ladies turn around and make a left hand star Pick up your partner, Star Promenade (couples half sashayed) Inside out, outside in (ladies back out, gents walk forward to make a star, can turn 1 1/2) Centers back out, Circle Left, Swing your original Partner, Promenade

Modern Variation for Heads/Sides in the center:

Everybody go forward and back Heads/Sides make a right hand star Heads/Sides turn around and make a left hand star Pick up your corner, Star Promenade Inside out, outside in (centers back out, outsides walk forward to make a star, can turn 1 1/2) Centers back out, Circle Left (this is a boy, boy, girl, girl circle) Gents Swing the nearest lady, Promenade to the man's home (partner change) Four Ladies Left Hand Star to your original partner, Swing
