INTERLOCKED DIAMONDS (5/99)

Starting Formation: Interlocked Diamonds - Two adjacent diamonds in which the very centres work with the furthest 3 dancers. Normal Interlocked Diamonds would be obtained from 2-faced lines plus a Centres Hinge, Very Centres Trade and Very Centres Run.

INTERLOCKED DIAMOND CIRCULATE

Action: Interlocked Diamond Circulate - Each dancer moves forward one position in the interlocked diamond path. (Centre goes to far diamond, In-facing point goes to far centre) Ending Formation: Int. diamonds

FLIP THE INTERLOCKED DIAMOND

Action: Flip the Interlocked Diamond - points Flip the Diamond while the centres Interlocked Diamond Circulate. Ending Formation: Waves or if facing diamonds then 2-faced line

CUT THE INTERLOCKED DIAMOND Action: Cut the Interlocked Dia-

HEADS STAR THRU and CALIFORNIA TWIRL, VEER LEFT, CROSSFIRE, SIN-GLE HINGE, MEN TRADE, MEN RUN, EACH 4 CROSSFIRE, [SCOOT BACK], SWING, PROMENADE
